Statutory Consultation to relocate and increase the capacity of Ysgol Gymraeg Y Fenni

I am writing to update you on the proposed relocation and associated increase in capacity of Ysgol Gymraeg Y Fenni. You will be aware that, following a period of consultation running between 29th January and 11th March 2024, a consultation report relating to these proposals was published to all consultees on 7th June 2024. This report provided feedback on the comments and concerns raised during the consultation period, together with the Council's response.

The Council's Cabinet met on the 5th June 2024 to consider the consultation report and the recommendations made to them. The decision made by Cabinet was to proceed to the next stages of the statutory process required to relocate and increase the capacity of Ysgol Gymraeg Y Fenni from 1st September 2025.

The proposals outlined above must now be published by way of statutory notice. The statutory notice (attached) will be formally published on **Friday 21st June 2023**

The statutory notice will be published:

- On the council website at [School Reorganisation - Monmouthshire](#)
- On or near the main entrance of Ysgol Gymraeg Y Fenni.
- On or near the main entrance of the proposed new site at Llwynu Lane, Abergavenny, NP7 6AR
- By distribution to all statutory consultees, the notice may be distributed to consultees by email.

The publication of the statutory notice will open the statutory objection period, therefore, anyone wishing to make a statutory objection against the proposal can do so. To be considered as a statutory objection, objections must be made in writing or by email, and sent to the Council within 28 days of the date on which the notice was published.

Objections should be sent to School & Student Access Unit, Monmouthshire County Council, County Hall, Usk, NP15 1GA or by email to strategicreview@monmouthshire.gov.uk.

For clarity, the closing date for statutory objections is **19th July 2023**.


Important: You must respond during the statutory objection period if you wish for your concerns raised during the consultation stage of this process to be treated as statutory objections. Feedback received in the consultation stage of this process **will not** automatically be considered as statutory objections.

The summary timeline below has been included for easy reference of next steps in this statutory process:

Consultation Stage	Date
Statutory Notices published and the Statutory Objection period opened	21st June 2024
Statutory Objection Period closes	19th July 2024
Publication of Objection Report	September 2024
Cabinet to consider Objection Report and determine whether proposals are to be implemented	September 2024
Proposals Implemented (if agreed)	1st September 2025
