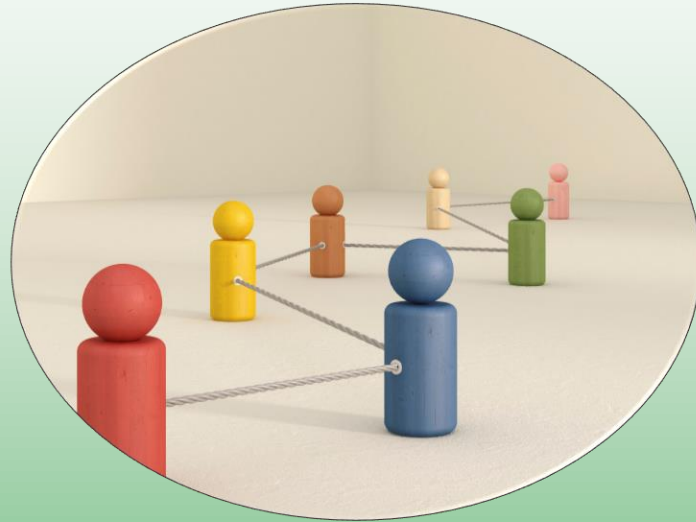




# Our impact and social value

2023/2024 Financial Year





We supported over 30 young carers with direct 1:1 support around their caring role.

86% of whom experienced improved school attendance, improved wellbeing, and improved family resilience and relationships.

# Our group support for young carers



We facilitated groups for young carers across 8 of our primary and secondary schools, delivering sessions to 490 young people.

We facilitated community groups which delivered sessions to 37 young people.

Our groups offered young carers the chance to explore and receive guidance on their role, while also offering skills on budgeting, household tasks and duties, and cooking.
